

Smartphone info:

- If you want to download ebooks to your iPhone or Android-based smartphone, you will need the OverDrive Media Console app. It is available in their app store. They can also download it from: <http://www.overdrive.com/software/omc/> The Nook app (or any other app) will not work for this.
- The smartphone app will only show you the ebooks and audiobooks that will work on your phone. The titles that won't work don't show up in the app. You can access those via a PC.
- If you have a Blackberry or a phone using Windows Mobile, you will not be able to use ebooks yet. The app that is currently available for those platforms does not have ebook capability. A new version, incorporating ebooks is due out soon—perhaps in January

eReader info:

- People using a Sony Reader will need the Sony Library software, which can be downloaded directly from Sony here: <http://ebookstore.sony.com/download/> All other compatible ereaders use Adobe Digital Editions which is available for download via the KLU website.
- The software (whether Sony Library or Digital Editions) needs to be registered with an Adobe ID. You will be prompted to do this when you install the software. If you don't have an Adobe ID, you will have the option to create one at that time. The only information you must provide to Sony is a name and email address.
- The ereader must also be registered to the **SAME** Adobe ID. You will be prompted to do this the first time you plug in and try to transfer something to your reader.
- People with a Pandigital Novel may need a firmware update before KLU ebooks will function correctly. They can update their device from this site: <http://www.pandigital.net/Downloads/>
